

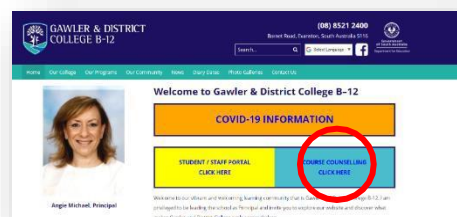


# Gawler & District College B-12 Year 11 | 2024 Subject Selection Form

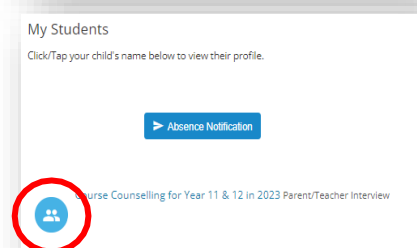
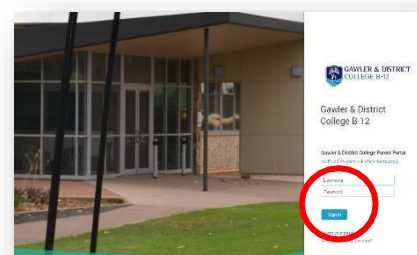
