The Scholarships will be awarded at the discretion of the Gawler & District College B-12 Foundation and will be determined by the applicant's ability to meet the *selection criteria* as outlined above.

Recipients will be required to follow the student expectations of Gawler & District College B-12 as well as attend and talk at Foundation activities during the 2024 year.

Successful applicants will be advised in December 2023 and will be presented with the details of the scholarship at the Awards Presentation Ceremony on Wednesday 6th December 2023. (Term 4 Week 8)
