



Gawler & District College B-12 ICT End User Agreement

Please read and understand the Gawler & District College ICT End User Agreement, the full version of which is available for download here: <https://www.gdc.sa.edu.au/our-college/forms/> which contains the following information:

- Cyber-safety strategies.
- Acceptable use and care of college ICT equipment and devices for both school and home use.
- Internet use and Cloud Services.

I / We understand that failure to comply with the ICT User Agreement could result in:

- Recall of the device and/or charges for cost associated with repairs or replacement of the device while in the care and of the student
- Consequences as set out in the ICT End User Agreement.

In my responsibilities as a Parent or Caregiver I will:

- Read the ICT End User Agreement carefully and discuss it with my child so we both have a clear understanding of our roles in using the college ICT devices for learning;
- Ensure that my child is aware of their responsibilities;
- Encourage my child to follow the cyber-safe strategies and all other advice set out in the Agreement;
- Contact the college if there is any aspect of this ICT User Agreement I would like to discuss;
- Contact the college if I wish to opt-out of any mentioned cloud services;
- Ensure the return of the device to the college at the end of term 4 each year (or upon the student leaving the college).
- Ensure this ICT End User Agreement is signed by myself and my child and returned to the college.

In return, Gawler & District College B-12 will commit to:

- Enhancing learning through the safe use of ICTs. This includes restricting access to inappropriate, illegal or harmful material on the internet or on school ICT equipment/devices, or other school related activities; and enforcing the cyber-safety requirements detailed in the ICT End User Agreement;
- Working in cooperation with children and their families to encourage and develop an understanding of the importance of cyber-safety through education designed to complement and support the ICT User Agreement initiative.
- Provide our students with strategies to keep themselves safe in a connected online world;
- Respond to any breaches of this agreement in an appropriate manner;
- Welcome enquiries parents / caregivers / legal guardians or students about cyber-safety concerns.

On receipt of this signed agreement, my child will be issued with a device for use at school through Years R - 7 and a take home device through Years 8 -12 for the duration of the school year. I am aware that a take home device can also be optional for Years 8 - 12.

Damage, loss, or failure to return the device may incur charges for device repair, up to the cost of a full device replacement subject to parts availability.

I/We are aware that we will be invoiced for any neglectful or wilful damage and that this is our agreement of liability for such. I/We have read and understand the conditions of the Gawler & District College ICT End User Agreement.
